BELLE ISLE HISTORY

Have you ever wondered where the name Belle Isle comes from?

Belle île is the French for beautiful island, but Belle Isle is built on a hill on the way south out of Leeds. One idea is that it is from Bell Hill, coming from the distinctive "bell"-shaped early coal mining bell pits of the hilly area. A "Newbell-ile" at Middleton Wood End is mentioned in the Rothwell parish register for 1762.

We know that in the late 1700s, Belle Isle was just a small hamlet for workers at a colliery opposite Middleton

Woods, near the current site of Middleton colliery railway. Belle Isle now is largely made up of housing estates built on farming land by the Council during the clearance of slum dwellings and the expansion of Leeds during the last century.

Both sessions are run by volunteers. They have been serving cooked breakfasts on Friday mornings for 5 years. Volunteers come in at 7.30am to get started and following last orders at 10.30am finish serving by 11am before sitting down to a well-deserved breakfast of their own. Then the clean up begins. **Founder Steph Horner said, "We set it up to support people who need help. We enjoy working as a team and giving something to the community". Everyone who attends is asked for a**



donation. It is voluntary but everyone is asked to chip in what they can.

Tasty Tuesdays is run by the same volunteers and serves soup and toasties from 10.30am to 12pm on Tuesdays. At times they will cook their own soup from scratch and they have served jacket potatoes.

If you are looking for work or want to find a better job, we might be able to help you in BITMOs GATE. Here are 10 ways we can help you to get that job you are looking for.

- Have you got a great-looking CV? Most jobs want a CV these days and we can help you get one, or improve the one you have got.
- 2. Use our computers or free Wi-Fi to search for work, including uploading your CV to sites like Indeed and Totaljobs.
- **3.** Our jobs board is updated regularly with local vacancies.
- 4. 16-24? We can set you up with an appointment with a jobs advisor who will meet you in BITMOs GATE to help you find work. We can help get you a work placement with top companies like Marks & Spencer and Boots through the Prince's Trust.
- 5. Want to improve your English, Maths or computer skills? We arrange courses in BITMOs GATE run by Leeds City College.
- 6. If you have any kind of disability, long-term health condition or suffer from anxiety or depression we have a pre-employment course run by Scope to help you get ready for applying for work, training or voluntary work. The course is on Tuesday and Friday mornings from January 14.
- 7. Becoming a volunteer could help improve your confidence and would look good on your CV. There are volunteer jobs you can do in BITMOs GATE and in the local area.
- 8. If you have a job interview coming up we can arrange interview practice for you to help you do better.
- **9.** Engage Leeds run a session to help you find work or get a better job in BITMOs GATE every Thursday afternoon from 2-4pm. No appointment necessary.
- **10.** Register with us and we will make sure that you find out about training courses, jobs fairs, vacancies and offer as much support as we can.

NEED HELP REGISTERING WITH LEEDS HOMES OR BIDDING?

Drop-in with Keith in BITMOs GATE Tuesdays 2-4pm or Thursdays 10am – 12pm

In order to complete the application you will need

- National Insurance Numbers for you (and any joint applicant)
- A contact mobile number and email address
- The full names and dates of birth of everyone on the application
- Five years' address history for the main and joint applicant(s) with no missing dates

You need to provide the following information the details of all household members, including any support workers assisting you, any pregnancies within the household or overnight child access arrangements and overnight carers' requirements and your current income

PROOFS FOR <u>ALL</u> ADULTS:

Two items from **GROUP A**; **OR** One item from **GROUP A** and one from **GROUP B**; **OR** Three items from **GROUP B** At least one item must confirm the current address.

Proofs for all children under 16

We will only accept a birth certificate and a current Child Benefit award letter or Child Tax Credit award letter which must include your name and address and the child's name.

The first two quarters of the year have been very busy with preparations for the continuation ballot, team training and improving our services to tenants. We have focused on our debt collection service to make sure we've got the right staff in place with the right support to maximise our debt collection and also to help customers who are in financial difficulty. The thing that "Housing folk" hate more than anything is evicting people for breaches of tenancy conditions and failure to pay rent on time, which is why we work so hard to encourage prompt payment in full.

We've helped over 50 customers to get on a better financial footing, and generated over £22,000 in additional income for them, which in turn helps them to pay their rent on time.

We have just started a piece of work to look at how we can improve our front line service to you, to make sure you get the right answers and service each time you contact us. We will be asking you for your opinions on our service delivery so keep a look out on Facebook for surveys and updates on progress. We've made a big investment in staff training this year and will continue to make sure our staff have the tools and support they need to make a difference to Belle Isle.

The GATE has been a very busy place this year with 467 people registering under our new membership system to become regular visitors in the first seven months, taking advantage of the sessions we run in collaboration with Leeds City College, Scope, Red Ladder Theatre Company and so many more. Next year we will be working even harder on supporting BITMO tenants to access training education and employment.

We have just completed our Board Strategy event and Staff Away Day and are brimming with ideas about what we want to do over the next five years to improve services, make Belle Isle a safer stronger community and remain a well-run organisation. We will be consulting residents on these ideas before we finalise our five year plan, so again look out for opportunities to be involved. Events will be advertised on Facebook.

COMMUNITY MEETINGS – RIGHT UP YOUR STREET

There is a community meeting that covers your neighbourhood. Residents come together between two and four times a year and meet with BITMO, police and local councillors. Issues affecting your community are discussed – from speeding cars in the back streets to rubbish collections to anti-social behaviour as well as proposals for improvements like fencing or children's play areas. The police, councillors and BITMO give up-to-date information and anyone can ask questions or bring points up. Some of the local meetings have organised walkabouts, where residents, police, BITMO and councillors have looked at the areas on foot together and seen what needs to be done. Others have organised drop-ins, where anyone who can't make or doesn't like attending meetings can still put their point across individually and have it raised for them at the meeting.
