BITMO provides extra services — but sometimes the housing counter has to shut

BITMO is controlled by the tenants of Belle Isle. We are very proud of the extra services that we provide over and above those provided by many councils or housing associations. We have a caretaking team where often this is contracted out to private cleaning companies. We run the BITMOs GATE community centre along with our team of local volunteers. We offer a £70,000 a year BITMO Community Fund. We run a series of free food and activity events in school holidays as well as free tutoring for Year 3 and 4 pupils.

We have our repairs contractor Mears based in our offices next to our repairs team, not a remote site,

which helps provide a co-ordinated repairs service.

We are also really proud to run a housing counter, open 30 hours a week, where you can walk in and talk to housing staff directly. Many other housing organisations offer a call centre only, or you have to go to a community hub where you can talk to general council staff who will pass a message to your housing for you.

But sometimes the housing counter has to close. BITMO is a small organisation and so when our staff are away from work – for example on leave, unwell or training – we can't always keep the housing counter open. At these times we will always provide a full telephone service on 0113 378 2188. If your call goes to voicemail – probably because our staff are taking other calls – please leave a message and we will call you back. BITMO's Board Benefits Belle Isle

BITMO is run by a Board of elected Belle Isle tenants, with some co-opted members and two Leeds councillors. They meet regularly during the year to make decisions about the overall running of BITMO.

Here are some of the decisions made at the January meeting.

- * The budget for the next year was agreed, with £200,000 taken from reserves to be spent on making homes cheaper to heat.
- * Planned works we will spend £1.9million improving homes in Belle Isle this year. The planned investment programme is drawn up using information from the stock condition database, repairs trends, local knowledge and customer requests. In the next 12 months we are going to replace 24 kitchens and 4 bathrooms, provide new roofs to 15 properties on Middleton Road, and we will carry out thermal efficiency work to 34 properties on Windmill Road. Where tenants have large rent arrears or other tenancy breaches, the work will not be carried out until they have been resolved.



BITMO'S Board has set up a fund to support people in Belle Isle. You can apply for funds for:

- * Essential furniture or decorations you can't afford
- * Help with the costs of training or education courses
- * Funds to improve green spaces or run community groups.
